
SUGGESTED INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR BAHAMA SHUTTER

- 1. Lay the shutters out on a smooth plane (carpeted or grassy area) with front side up
- 2. Install arms with the ¼" nylon washer and 2" screws to the side of the shutter. Use collar and thumb screw to hold blade assembly together
- 3. Install camel back and hockey stick to arms
- 4. Drill 5/16" hole in center of top hinge and 12" on center at each side of the center hole. A screw must be placed within three inches of each side of the top hinge
- 5. Center Bahama vertically and horizontally on opening. If a sill exists, set Bahama on the sill and leave at least a 1/8" clearance at bottom
- 6. Fasten center hole on hinge first, then level and finish mounting
- 7. Set camel backs bottom edge to bottom side of shutter and fasten camel back to wall
- 8. Mark and drill hole in sides of shutter where camel back lines up
- 9. Impact shutters mount Z bars around shutter. The Z bars are only used to lock down shutter in a storm
- 10. Non-Impact shutters attach flutter bars to double jambs at the bottom of shutter if required
- 11. Open and set arms with thumbscrews
- 12. Wipe the shutter down with a wet clean cloth and mild soap
